Through his research endeavors, Dr. Razzaqi gained

valuable laboratory experience in stem cell processing, magnetic bead cell separation, flow cytometry and cloning. His research focused on accelerating immune recovery after hematopoietic stem cell transplantation.

He visited fourth-grade classes in the community, presenting the health benefits of not smoking along with other educational facts related to smoking and advertising.
